



The White Mountain Shooters Association is pleased to announce our affiliation with the Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP). About the CMP:

The CMP is a federally chartered 501(c)(3) corporation that places its highest priority on serving youth through gun safety and marksmanship activities that encourage personal growth and build life skills. Links on this page will lead you to more detailed information about the CMP and its programs. The federal law enacted in 1996 (*Title 36 U. S. Code, 40701-40733*) that created the Corporation for the Promotion of Rifle Practice and Firearms Safety, Inc. (CPRPFS, *the formal legal name of the CMP*) mandates these key “functions for the corporation:

1. To instruct citizens of the United States in marksmanship;
2. To promote practice and safety in the use of firearms;
3. To conduct competitions in the use of firearms and to award trophies, prizes, badges, and other insignia to competitors.

The law specifically states: *In carrying out the Civilian Marksmanship Program, the corporation shall give priority to activities that benefit firearms safety, training, and competition for youth and that reach as many youth participants as possible.*

Here are some of the benefits of being a CPM Affiliate:

1. Ammunition and Rifle purchases for WMSA members (M1 Garand and Club Rifle Sales)
2. Opportunities to host sanctioned pistol and rifle matches, Excellence in Competition (EIC) Rifle and Pistol.
