Operating Policy

6.0 RANGE RENTAL

The Second Knoll Target Range facilities are available for rental for special events or instruction pursuant to the following guidelines.

- A. Shooting Bays, the 100 yd. Public Range or the 50 yd Range may be rented by contacting the WMSA Baywatch scheduler in advance of the event.
1. All required documentation and fees, including waivers for all shooters and observers and a Daily Shooters Log must be completed/collected prior to beginning operations.
 2. WMSA sanctioned Clubs may use the Shooting Bays at no charge subject to the provisions of Policy 4.2 Club Matches.
 3. The 100 yd. Public Range may not be rented or used for instruction during public shooting hours.
 4. Coaching (one on one, non-paid individual supervision) is permitted on the 100 yd. Public Range during public shooting hours subject to all Second Knoll Target Range Safety Rules and Policies.
 5. A WMSA RSO must be present during events or instruction unless a preapproved certified instructor is conducting a course.
 6. The fee for Shooting Bay/Range rental is \$20 for ½ day or \$40 for a full day.
 7. Rental fees for special events may be waived by BOD vote.
- B. Instructors must provide the following documentation prior to scheduling Range facilities:
1. Copy of Nationally Recognized Credentials – NRA, Military, POST (Police Officer Standards and Training), etc.

2. Copies of insurance naming WMSA Inc., AZ Game and Fish Department, and U.S. Forest Service as covered parties.
- C. Range Bays may be rented for shooting events by entities not associated with WMSA. Entities renting bays for shooting events must provide:
1. Copies of insurance naming WMSA Inc., AZ Game and Fish Department, and U.S. Forest Service as covered parties.
 2. NRA or WMSA RSO coverage for the entire event.
- D. WMSA RSOs may halt any training which is manifestly unsafe (e.g. shooting with people down range, guns pointed up range, etc.)
